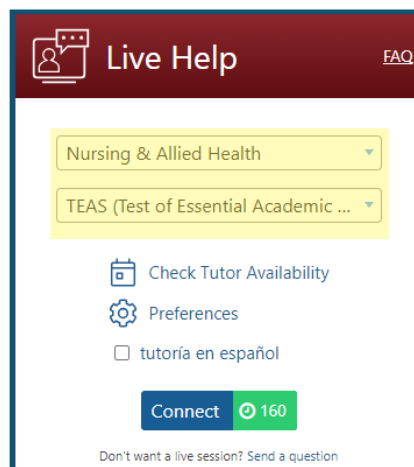
## 3. Brainfuse Online Tutoring

Available to current DMACC students through your myDMACC portal. To access Brainfuse tutoring: log in to your myDMACC account: select “Tools” > “Tutoring” > “Brainfuse”

1. In the “Live Help” window: Select Topic = “Nursing and Allied Health” and Subject = “TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills)”
2. Select “Connect” when you are ready to talk to a tutor

Important information:

- “Check Tutor Availability” will show the hours online live tutoring is available. The hours are normally Sunday – Thursday, 6-10 pm CST
- To use your time efficiently, have questions and topics you need assistance with prepared and ready for the tutor
- DMACC students may use up to 160 hours per semester of tutoring across all subjects
